We had the privilege of hosting a group of Physician's Assistants from Kings College in Pennsylvania. They worked tirelessly over three days and were able to see 430 patients from all over the neighborhood. They also saw children from two orphanages that aren't able to get affordable medical care in their area. They treated a wide range of illnesses, and also distributed

glasses to those with vision impairment. We are grateful to offer this service to those in our community who may not be able to otherwise afford medication for a basic and treatable ailment. It's because of partnerships with others, like Kings College, that we are able to continue hosting short-term clinics.

Paul was able to speak with them several times about the importance of baptism and what it means, and we were blessed to have three baptisms in July through youth programming! Back to School

The school year officially started on September 9th!

This year, 10 of the girls will be attending a school off-site. They're all in secondary school now - they're growing so quickly!

That means eight of the girls will continue attending Patti's School, which is located on HOH grounds.

Each girl received a new backpack, new shoes, school supplies, and a new uniform. We are so thankful we can provide the HOH girls with these basic necessities, with the help of our generous sponsors!

School is a big expense for most families in Haiti, especially families with multiple children. Over 90% of schools in Haiti are private, and with over 59% living on an average of \$2/day education is difficult and costly for families to provide. We are fortunate to be able to offer Patti's School to our community at a very affordable rate for children kindergarten up to sixth grade!

Even though the school year has technically started, the girls have missed several days already. Haiti is experiencing a gasoline shortage, which creates a domino effect of struggles and circumstances. The people are frustrated, leading to protests that sometimes escalate to violent levels. These protests can be unpredictable, and can make travel to and from school too risky for students and teachers.

This last year has been especially overwhelmed with unrest and instability. We are praying for Haiti everyday, and ask that you please join us.
